- Must have or obtain an Independence, MO, Health Department Food Service Certificate.
- Wash pots, pans, dishes, and utensils.
- Put away clean pots, pans, dishes, and utensils.
- Assist in keeping kitchen areas clean and neat.
- Maintain proper wash and rinse temperatures on the dishwasher when in use.
- Sweep and mop kitchen and adjoining areas.
- Assist in preparation of and serving of camper snacks.
- Be a positive influence on campers, leading by example.
- Be aware of and follow all Three Trails Camp policies and procedures.
- Attend all staff and camp meeting.
- Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education: NA

Experience: Experience in food services preferred.

Certifications/Licenses: Must have or obtain Independence MO, Health Department Food Service Certificate or certification from approved city or program.

Skills/Abilities: Ability to work long hours with limited breaks.

Supervisory Responsibility: NA

Safe from Harm Level: Level 3 Camp Training

Blood borne Pathogen Level: Level 3

Physical Requirements:

Speaking, hearing and vision ability, and excellent manual dexterity to be able to perform food prep duties.

Lifting, pulling, and pushing of materials up to 15 pounds.

Requires bending, squatting and walking.

Standing up to 6-8 hours per day.

Driving: In order to drive Salvation Army vehicles, employee must possess a valid driver's license from the state in which you reside. Must be approved through The Salvation Army Fleet Safety Program to drive either a Salvation Army or personal vehicle on Salvation Army business. Driving not a requirement of this position.

Working Conditions: Work is performed in the camp dining hall and does include weekdays and weekends based on the summer camp and divisional schedule.
